

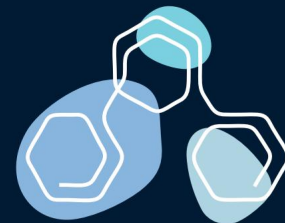

In 2025-2026, the JFBM and eJFBM were a great success, thus announcing a particularly rich and diverse scientific program for the next JFBM in autumn 2026.

It is therefore with immense pleasure and great pride that we will welcome you to Le Havre for the 9th edition of the JFBM.

As in previous years, the heart of these days will be a series of 33 workshops spread over three days, from Wednesday 14 to Friday 16 October 2026. In partnership with local stakeholders, an opening roundtable discussion on the theme of "Health and the Environment" will kick off these days. Furthermore, in keeping with Le Havre's maritime identity, we will conclude this edition with a high-level scientific conference dedicated to marine pollution and its impacts on health.

I would also like to highlight the space dedicated to scientific posters, a true reflection of the dynamism of our community. Open to all, it will offer young professionals as well as more experienced colleagues the opportunity to present their work, share their ideas, and create enriching exchanges for their professional development.

On behalf of the entire scientific committee, I wish you stimulating days, rich in discoveries, exchanges and encounters, and hope that you will fully enjoy your stay in Le Havre.

- Microbiology
- Eco-responsible biology, laboratory organization, accreditation, quality assurance
- Toxicology, therapeutic monitoring

Creating an account is required to submit an abstract. This requires at least one author to register for the French-Speaking Days of Medical Biology (JFBM). Instructions for authors on preparing the abstract and poster are available on the jfbm.fr website.

Poster preparation and submission

After notification of acceptance of the abstract, the poster is prepared using the A0 portrait format template that you will receive with the notification.

The poster must be uploaded in PDF format to the website jfbm.fr

The printing of the poster in "paper format" is provided by the JFBM organization and benefits from display throughout the duration of the days.

Selection for the "180 Second Challenge"

The scientific committee selects around ten posters to participate in the "180 Second Challenge" session.

The authors will give an oral presentation of their work in 180 seconds, on Friday, October 16, 2026, from 11:15 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.

At the end of this session, four posters chosen by the scientific committee will be awarded a JFBM poster prize.

Registration fees for the scientific program

Registration for JFBM is done exclusively online. Registration confirmation and paid invoice.

Your registration details will be sent upon receipt of payment. These fees include: documentation, access to conference rooms, training workshops, the partner area, posters, and breaks. Participants will receive a professional training contract and a certificate of attendance. Full registration fees must be paid before the conference; each participant is responsible for seeking reimbursement of any expenses incurred. Cancellation is free of charge until September 13, 2026. After this date, payments are non-refundable.

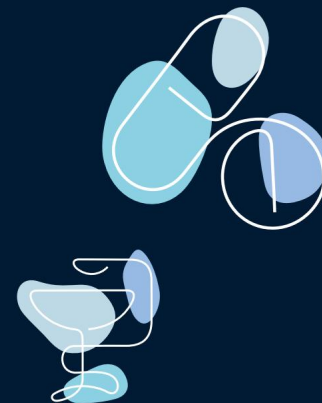

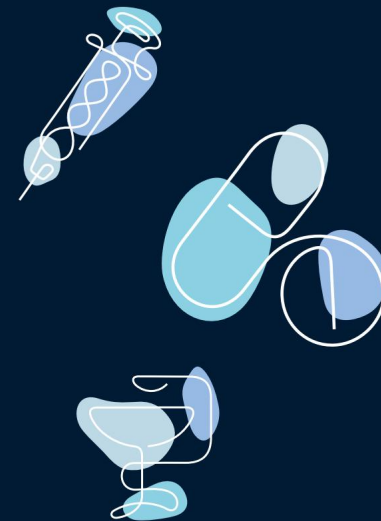
